



Preparing for your imaging appointment at The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital

Advice on preparing for your imaging appointment

We would like to advise you of changes we are making and assure you about the actions we are taking when you attend for your appointment.

Do not attend if you have symptoms

Firstly, if you or any member of your household is showing symptoms of Coronavirus please do not attend your appointment. Inform us, and we will rearrange your appointment.

Limited numbers of patients

We are limiting the amount of people on site wherever possible. Please attend your appointment alone without any relatives or carers unless strictly necessary.

When you arrive

Please enter the hospital using gate C, through the main entrance. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to your appointment time. You may be asked to wait outside if the waiting area is full to maintain social distancing.

Hand hygiene

There will be someone to greet you at the hygiene station, located inside the main entrance. You will be asked to wear a face mask if you are not already.

Social distancing

To maintain social distancing please keep to the left-hand side of the corridor.

We are making sure that our waiting rooms maintain social distancing by booking fewer patients than normal. In-patients will be in a separate area to out-patients.

Personal Protective Equipment

The staff you meet will be wearing protective masks, gloves and aprons for both yours and their safety.

Waiting rooms

Time has been allocated to allow all equipment to be thoroughly cleaned between each patient in accordance with government guidelines.
